Within this context, the Student Session is an **excellent training** for students in different respects. The students have the opportunity to **prepare their own submission** and experience the entire cycle of the selection process, as well as receive **feedback** from both **fellow students and leading experts** in the corresponding field.

All submissions will be **peer-reviewed** and accepted paper submissions will be assigned a **20 minute slot for presentation**. The extent to which the audience has understood the details should be the criterion by which the presentations are judged.

Moreover, all accepted submissions will be **published in online proceedings**.
